The three-story apartment building was built to “Passive House” specifications that will keep heating and cooling costs low. Boasting wellness and community rooms, a central laundry area and other offerings. Project partners have highlighted the building’s easy accessibility to Roxbury Park, summertime concerts at the historic band shell, several churches and neighborhood restaurants. The multi-million dollar Roxbury apartment complex was developed partly through tax credit support from the state financing agency. Roxbury Place’s apartments are designated for people ages 55 and older whose incomes fall under specific lower income guidelines.
